
#### WHY RICHBOROUGH?

- LOGISTICS LOG JAM BY 1916
- INCREASE IN MANPOWER & SUPPLIES
- SECRET, SHELTERED & SECURE LOCATION
- ROMAN & MEDIAEVAL
- RIVER STOUR LOW TIDAL RANGE
- SUITABLE FOR BARGES
- LARGE GRAVEL BEDS BUILDING
- AMPLE SPACE

#### THE PROBLEM

- PREPARATION FOR SOMME
- 7 WEEKS LODGING FOR 400,000 MEN 100,000 HORSES
- NEW TRENCHES, ROADS & RAILWAYS
- WATER SUPPLY & PUMPING STATIONS
- AMMUNITION, FOOD & EQUIPMENT
- TRAFFIC AT FRICOURT IN ONE DAY:
- '26,000 TROOPS, 568 LIGHT MOTOR CARS, 617 MOTORCYCLES, 813 LORRIES, 3,200 HORSE DRAWN WAGONS 333 MOTOR AMBULANCES ETC....

#### **PURPOSE**

- ESSENTIALLY A MILITARY FERRY TERMINAL
- LARGE TROOP & STORES DEPOTS
- CONNECTION TO MAIN LINE SE & C RAILWAY
- RELIEVING PRESSURE ON SHIPPING UBOAT LOSSES
- TROOPS & EQUIPMENT OUT CASUALTIES
  & SCRAP BACK
