Instrumentation: two or more spoken voices

ASAT is a series of events for which vocalists interpret the score within varied situations.

- An event should explore different types of situations, e.g. concert hall, audience interaction, installation.
- The quote is divided into four sections: "As sure as time", "history is repeating itself", "and as sure as man is man", "history is the last place he'll look for his lesson".
- Using the table as a guide and the blank template, a realisation score should be made with differing indeterminate instructions for each section. Although the instructions are predetermined, the nature of these instructions allow for individual interpretation.
- The first vocalist should start first and on the first section.
- Each remaining vocalist can start at any time after the first vocalist, but on any other section.
- Each vocalist should spend a minimum of two minutes on each section, and should enact the sections in order (unless instructed otherwise).
- Each vocalist may finish when they are on the final section.
- The event ends when all vocalists have finished.
